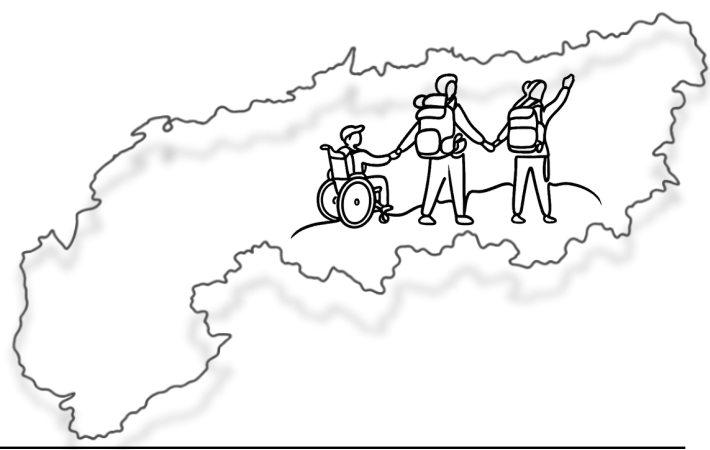


YOUTH PARTICIPATION IN THE ALPINE CONVENTION

Travel costs can be paid back.

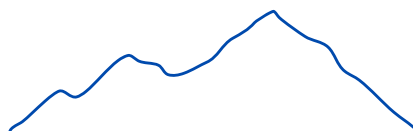
The project receives funding from the German Environment Agency.
